Chincholi lies in the Kalaburagi district and is most popular for the "chandrapalli" Dam. It is built across river Bhima and is situated in chandrapalli village. Built in 1973, it has six spillway gates. Since it is located between two mountains with the Götam Gota forest in the background, it is bestowed with abundant natural beauty.

Chandrapalli dam, along with four smaller dams provide water to habitats of this wildlife sanctuary.

The dam was constructed during 1973, and has been providing irrigation facilities to many villages of chincholi taluka. The dam is defined as earthen Dam with left bank spillway. since it was constructed to serve as an irrigation project . it has been formed as single purpose dam.

The Gottam Gotta forest envelops the dam on all sides. An island on the Dam has become a popular destination for sightseers. The length of the Dam is 926 metres, and its height is 28.65 metres. There are wide range of activities made available to tourist who visit the dam. The dam lies near the thick cover of forests. This has become the main reason why trekking and camping have emerged as an attraction to the region.

The dawn was full of peace and we felt very relaxed after viewing the view of the chandrampatti dam. The greenery, deep water, the water falling from the gateway that sounds just like 'ahh' completely relaxing.

We all enjoyed the mountain view and dam view which made us laugh with our inner heart beauty. 
Gottam Gutta





